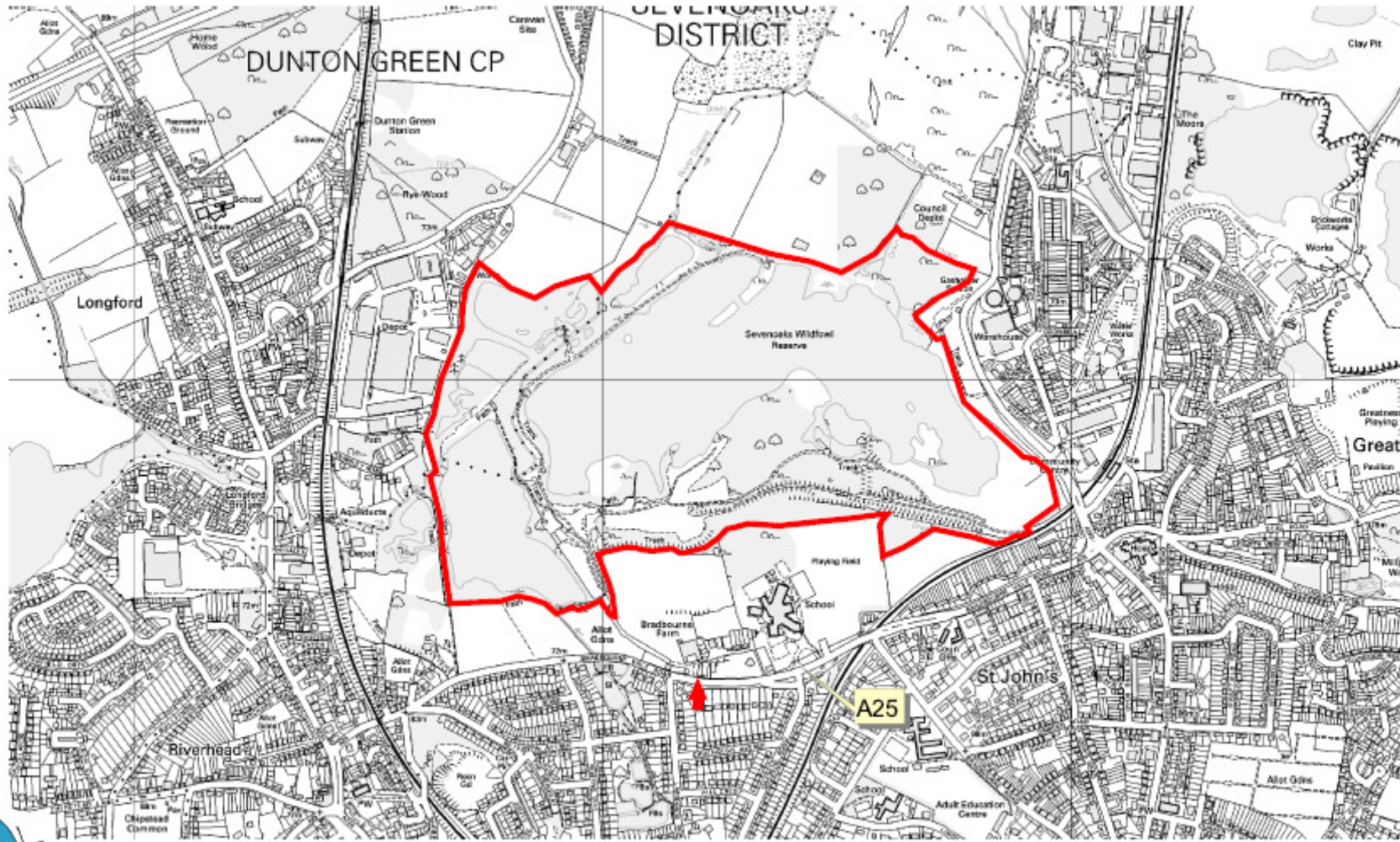

Subjects to be covered	The day will cover primarily wetland bird species with some woodland and parkland species.
