

KWT Web Map App Guide



Annotated screen grab of how the map looks when it opens

Open drop-down menu to select to search by address, KWT Reserve or another layer.

Toggle between different base maps and aerial imagery.

Search by postcode, address, or search for a particular site in a layer.

Click on a biodiversity area to bring up a pop-out window with the site details.

Click to open a map legend showing ticked on layers only

Click to open the High Biodiversity Areas Layer list

Click to close the layer list

Click to open menu to turn on/off any layers

Minimise the layer list to see more of the map.

Click here to adjust layer transparency, change the order of the layers, or zoom to a whole layer.

Tick/clear the boxes to turn on or off layers you need/don't need.

Click (or scroll with mouse) to zoom in/out.

Return to default county overview.

Zoom to your current location if using on GPS enabled hardware.

Scale bar.

Click here to read off OS grid ref. when you click on a map location.
