Task Info

This is a varied site including lakes, ponds, reed beds, scrub, woodland and meadows, but we are never too far from water so wellington boots are advised in the winter!

Why is it important?

The reserve is a Special Site for Scientific interest and it is the first gravel pit site in England to be turned into a nature reserve. The Tuesday team is key to maintaining the variety of habitats it contains which are needed in order to support the greatest biodiversity.

Commitment: Every Tuesday. Come weekly, monthly or on an ad-hoc basis.

Training: Full training is given and you'll only be asked to do work you are comfortable with. There is also the option to do further training in machinery or team leading too.
