The scheme is open to anyone who gardens in a wildlife friendly way in Kent and Medway.

If you are under the age of 18 you must have permission to enter from your parent or guardian. By submitting an entry, your parent/carer/guardian is deemed to have given such consent and to agree to the use of the entry as described in these terms and conditions.

The closing date for submissions is **14 June 2020**. All submissions received after this time will not be eligible. Please note that sending is not proof of receipt.

The Organisers cannot be held responsible for emails that do not arrive due to the entrant's email security settings or restrictions placed by their Internet service provider.

Your entry can be submitted digitally via our online web form on our Wilder Gardens/ Wild About Gardens webpage or by paper entry forms available from our Visitor Centres.

By submitting an entry to Kent Wildlife Trust's Wild about Gardens Awards scheme each entrant confirms and warrants that they have received any necessary permission from the owner(s) of the garden referred to and will indemnify Kent Wildlife Trust against any claims made by any third parties in respect of such infringement.

The scheme is open to anyone who has, or is developing a Wildlife Friendly garden of any size and type; apart from schools who are referred to our Wilder Kent Awards.

AWARDS

Our volunteer wildlife gardening advisors visit as many entries as they are able to between April and August.

Certificates are awarded for Gold, Silver Gilt, Silver and Bronze levels. Gold award winners receive one of our small plaques. Gardens may also be nominated for one of our “special” awards, where a larger plaque will be awarded.

DATA PROTECTION

We will keep your details on our secure database for the duration of this year’s scheme and the two following years, should you decide to re-enter. We value your support and do not pass on information about you to any group or individual outside the Wildlife Trusts.

INDEMNITY AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

To the maximum extent permitted by law, Kent Wildlife Trust excludes its liability for any loss, damage, injury, cost or expense suffered by you, whether directly or indirectly and howsoever caused, in connection with the Awards scheme and use of any plaque or certificate.
