

This company is the first to become an approved buyer of our Wilder Carbon Standard for Nature and Climate, purchasing carbon units generated by the wilding of Heather Corrie Vale, a former golf course now managed for nature by Kent Wildlife Trust. They are also the first vertical farm to launch a branded salad into a major supermarket group. To secure their involvement, GrowUp Farms has proven that they are taking steps to demonstrably reduce their carbon emissions.
